IN SOUTH DAKOTA, FOCUS IS ON "POLITICAL DEADWOOD"

Conservatives and Constitutionalists across the region will gather together in a key 2014 election year this summer, at the "South Dakota for Freedom: An Evening with Patriots" event, sponsored by the Constitution Party of South Dakota. Lori Stacey, state chairman, and Curtis Strong, candidate for Governor, have been heavily involved in the running of the state party, and will be among the speakers that night.

Other speakers and performers include: Jordan Page, Tatiana Moroz, and from the Tenth Amendment Center — Michael Boldin. The Constitution Party is planning for a recordbreaking turnout. "We are trying to make an effort to reach out to Independents," Lori Stacey stated, "Republicans and Libertarians are obviously an audience to reach out to as well."

These words ring true all across the United States, as the Constitution Party aims to draw from all walks of life to elect true leaders who are dedicated to the preservation of the Constitutional Republic: people who are passionate about extracting the power out of Washington D.C. and placing it back in local and state governments. In an era where most surveys show the need for a viable third political party, there are plenty of issues for the Constitution Party candidates to focus on.

Stacey adds, "I have been trying to get the word out on the fact that Obamacare is null and void ever since the Supreme Court declared the penalty to be a tax. It originated in the Senate and that is (of course) forbidden for a revenue (tax) bill. It is basic rules of Congress to know which chamber can originate which types of bills." She continues with a theme that is echoing across the nation. "We need local and state-wide officers – and members of Congress – to have the courage to hold government accountable when proposed bills violate the Constitution and their oath of office.

We must start holding them accountable or we have no Constitution realistically, no laws — just a government of men".

Likewise, gubernatorial candidate Curtis Strong has a similar agenda and ideology. Strong states, "I started studying the Constitution a few years ago and am finding out how our elected officials discarded the Constitution. We were able to attend a Constitution class at the Independence Hall with <u>Rick Green</u>, which was an amazing experience".

His political agenda is local, but aligns well with the national platform of the Constitution Party:

- 1. Common Core out of South Dakota.
- 2. Agenda 21 out of South Dakota. (Agenda 21 is a United Nations manifesto and protocol that mandates certain carbon footprint and emissions standards at the expense of the economy.)
- 3. Arial spraying no longer funded by any county or by the State of South Dakota.
- 4. All EB 5 (Immigrant Investor streamlined green cards & citizenship) projects stopped in the State of South Dakota.
- 5. Stop the Affordable Care Act in South Dakota.
- 6. Supply the people of South Dakota an itemized budget.
- 7. Constitutional Carry (no handgun restrictions) implemented in South Dakota

What does Lori Stacey think about the multitude of people that still feel they are "obligated" to vote Republican? "These voters are doing the wrong thing by voting for a Republican just because they are a Republican, and not choosing the best candidate for the office. The solution is simple. Stop being chained to the Republican candidates that most voters are not happy with anyway. Choose the best individual candidate for the office sought and quit throwing your vote away on a party. You do not elect a party, you elect an individual person. Voters should make sure a candidate really reflects the ideals and integrity they expect".

Audacity: Free Software For Recording and **Editing Your Podcast**

Podcasting 101: What is **Podcasting and How Can** We Get in the Game?

If you, someone you know, or your state party is interested in extending your public outreach through podcasting, you might be interested in reviewing these two informative videos first.

WEBSITE: In the last month we have had over 12,600 visits to our <u>national website</u>. The top five places where people are finding the link to our website are: politics 1.com, Facebook, Wikipedia, disgus.com, and mrcammarata.edublogs.org. Internet search engines also bring in hundreds of seekers for the Constitutionist point-of-view.

Web Tip: We have designed the website to be a learning experience for our visitors by connecting together various media and organizations with the principles of our platform. Visit our Constitutional <u>Convention</u> platform plank for an example of how this works. We continually make improvements to this connectivity.

SOCIAL MEDIA: We are close to reaching 10,000 friends on Facebook thanks to everyone's willingness to share our posts, and a couple of Facebook Ads. Over 90% of our tweets are re-tweeted on Twitter to a growing audience of over 3,070. Our Google+ page has now received nearly 3000 +'s, and our growth continues on both LinkedIn, and Pinterest.

Social Tip: When you want to **share** a link to an article we have posted, and you'd like to share the text of our post as well, you can copy/paste it into the share box. Facebook automatically posts the text accompanying images, but it does not do so with posted links.

CP WIKIPEDIA PROJECT: Several Constitution Party State Party affiliate pages are slated by Wikipedia for deletion because there is not enough unique content or relevant news stories to support our viability. Jeff Becker, state secretary of the Constitution Party of West Virginia, is the national CP Wikipedia Project Coordinator. The greatest need is for volunteers to find positive news stories — past or present – online, which can then be linked to the Wikipedia pages under review.
